Works But Limited

Weather Radio Note 4

VHF/UHF Radio Systems Note 5

Notes:

1. Outdoors good, limited indoor coverage
2. Limited message information
3. Road, building entrances, limited visual range
4. Useful WX only in Tornado areas / season
5. Limited to staff

Cell Phones Note A, C

Land Line Telephones Note B

Cell Walkie Talkies Note A, C

Blackberry's and Similar Devices Note A, C

Reverse 911 Systems Note A, B, C

Notes:

- A. Cell Wireless systems have very limited channels and immediately become a serious constraint –Blocked/overloaded
- B. Switching systems overload at local and regional levels.
- C. Due to its use as a proven terrorist triggering system, governments may immediately shut down cell systems. It is alleged to have happened during one event.
