




WHAT IS AN EARTHQUAKE?

When the ground shakes, we call it an earthquake. Sometimes it shakes a little, and sometimes it shakes a lot. Earthquakes can damage buildings and make things fall. Sometimes people get hurt.


Earthquakes are sometimes followed by more quakes which are called aftershocks. They are usually smaller and can happen for many days or longer.






WHY DO EARTHQUAKES HAPPEN?

The surface of the EARTH is like a cracked eggshell.



The pieces are called PLATES. All the pieces are moving very slowly. Usually they are stuck together along their edges which are called FAULTS.



Sometimes the pieces SLIP quickly along FAULTS, and the GROUND SHAKES. This is called an EARTHQUAKE!





DURING AN EARTHQUAKE


When the ground shakes, or you get an ALERT (page 10), you should DROP where you are, COVER your head and neck, and HOLD ON.

- -stay away from glass and windows
- -do not stand in a doorway
- -do not run outside
- -if possible, get under a desk or table



EARLY WARNING SYSTEM

If you are close to an earthquake, you may get an ALERT on your cell phone, wireless device, TV, radio or PA system.

If you hear an ALERT, don't wait for shaking to...
DROP, COVER and HOLD on.

If you feel shaking or get an earthquake ALERT, it's time to... DROP, COVER and HOLD on.




Listen to your local radio station for updates on the earthquake.

If you have a real emergency, like a fire or serious injury, you can call 9-1-1. Remember to stay calm.

- SECURE HEAVY ITEMS so they don't fall.
- STAY CALM to make better decisions.
